

NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme: SNOMED Coding Guidance



Event	SNOMED CT	When to use
Non-diabetic hyperglycaemia	700449008	When a patient is identified to have Non-Diabetic Hyperglycaemia defined as a HbA1c between 42-47 mmol/mol or FPG between 5.5-6.9 mmols/l
NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme invitation	1090701000000104	When a primary care staff member invites a patient to be referred to the NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme. This may happen verbally, or via Letter or Text
Referral to NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme	1025321000000109	When a patient has been referred to the NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Provider via the form embedded in the clinical system
NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Started	1025271000000103	Upon receipt of notification from the NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Provider that a patient has started the programme
NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Not Completed	1025211000000108	Upon receipt of notification from the NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Provider that a patient has not completed the programme
NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Completed	1025251000000107	Upon receipt of notification from the NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme Provider that a patient has completed the programme
Referral to NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme declined	1025301000000100	When a patient has declined the NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme. This may happen prior to referral or following referral.
